SEND Pupils

It is important we establish pupil needs prior to the commencement on programme. During the initial meeting we will work with the pupil, parent/carer and the school to agree an individual support plan if required. Ensuring pupils are provided with the support they require to attend and achieve.

School on-site provision

On-site provision is currently delivered in **HAIRDRESSING** and **MUSIC TECHNOLOGY**. During the planning process, support is provided to ensure rooms used for delivery are fit for purpose.

Off-site attendance at Mode

Alternatively, pupils can attend Mode either as individuals or as a whole school group. Attendance is 1 or 2 days per week. All pupils work towards recognised qualifications as agreed with the school.

Our music technology team currently deliver one to one and group DJ & Production lessons in a number of primary & secondary schools across the city.

Tailored to meet the different needs of each school our current offer includes private lessons, after school clubs and working to the GCSE music curriculum standards to prepare year 10 & 11 students for their performance element using DJing.

Our in the centre/online alternative education & home schooling program is also delivered to the GCSE music curriculum standards covering a far wider range than just performance.

All equipment is provided for every session including mac computers with Ableton Live production software and industry standard DJ equipment consisting of Pioneer CDJ 3000's and Pioneer RX1 controllers.

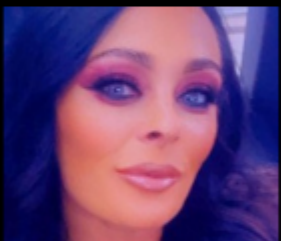
Michael Flood

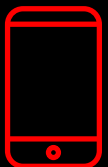
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
